Campbell the following described property situate in the County of Jackson in the State of Missouri; that is to say a certain Negro Boy named Thomas about nine years old (the same that is now in the possession of Oscar Bullard in the City of Kansas in the County and State aforesaid.

To Have and to Hold the said Negro Boy hereof conveyed unto the said William J. Gault and James R. Campbell their heirs and assigns forever Upon the express conditions Whereas the said William S. Bullard on the twenty ninth day of May A. D. 1850 made executed and delivered to the said William J. Gault and James R. Campbell his certain promissory note in words and figures following to wit

Kansas City May 29th 1850.

Twenty five days after date. I promise to pay William J. Gault and James R. Campbell or order the sum of Two hundred and seventy eight \$700 Dollars value received negotiable and payable without defalcation or discount with interest from date at the rate of ten per cent per annum and at the same rate until paid.

Know of the said William S. Bullard his executor or administrators shall pay the sum of money specified in said note and all the interest that may be due thereon according to the tenor and effect of said note with this exception shall be void otherwise it shall remain in full force and virtue in law.
