legal heirs of the said decedent, and bound with Black purchase

whereas the said William Hunt and wife Robert Thomas
of Shelton, David the Black, Keyes Black and Conner
Black heirs of the said decedent together with Aunt Anne
Mason and Relief of the said decedent purchased the said
Negro girl from said with Black by the means of purchase
and gift, and whereas Thomas the said heirs at law
speciously have given to the said Robert Black Mason and
Relief as a just price the said Negro girl in and during
the natural life of the said Robert Black. But to
avoid due right to them at the death of the said Robert Black
I have therefore I the said Robert Black do hereby
and by these presents contract to give with the said William
Hunt and Conner Black Thomas of Shelton, David
the Black, Keyes Black and Conner Black
that at my death the said Negro girl and all of her
increase shall with ~~me~~ to the said William Hunt
Conner Black, Thomas of Shelton, David the Black,
Keyes Black Conner Black to them and their
heirs forever, and that all the interest I the said Robert
Black have in and to the said Negro girl and all her
increase shall then with in them the said Susan Hunt
heirs of the said decedent and in consideration of the use
and occupation of the said Negro girl by me the said
Robert Black during my natural life

containing forty acres
And the North East quarter of the North West
quarter of Section No 36 of Township No 33 Range
No 10 of the 1st Range containing forty acres
Also the North East quarter
of the North East quarter of Section No 36 of Township
No 33 Range No 10 of the 1st Range containing forty acres
Also the North West quarter of the North West quarter
of Section No 36 of Township No 33 Range No 10 of the 1st Range
containing in all one hundred and six acres
To Have and to Hold the above described and
aforesaid granted premises to the said Casimiro Coluck
his heirs and assigns forever and the said William Arthur
and Melly Arthur his heirs do covenant with the said
Casimiro Coluck his heirs and assigns that they are lawfully
seized of the aforesaid granted premises with lawful
right to sell and convey the same to the said Casimiro Coluck
